	Empowered by your Spirit, may we be united in prayer and worship, and, in love and service, reach out as your hands across the world. In Jesus' name. Amen	

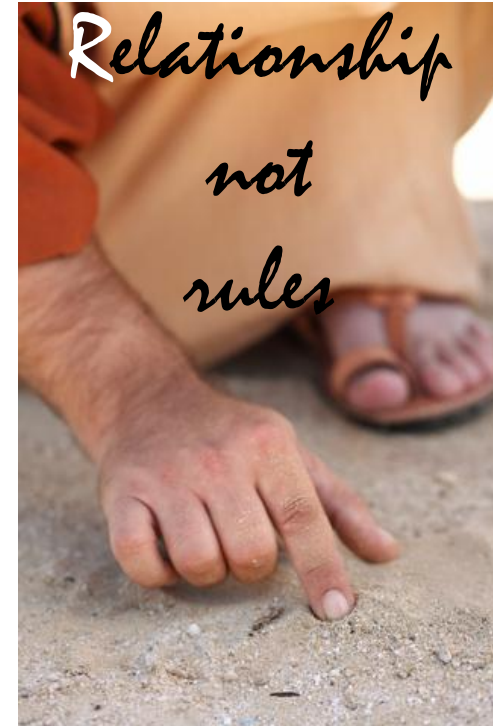
